Known Issues

- Reference Documents URL can't be opened when URL Prefix (eg. http) is not included.

- The link to the new Admin Tool 4.0.0.0 is missing from the redirected page users receive from the convenience link on the Form Builder Home page. They are directed to contact the NCI help desk which is only necessary if you don't have a VPN account and need access.
Workaround: The correct link is <http://cadsradmintool.nci.nih.gov/> which can be accessed by users connected via the NCI/NIH LAN or with VPN. If you need access and don't have a VPN account, contact the NCI help desk.
- Done button to go back to Form Builder from CDE Browser does not exist. Newly added cart items are not refreshed in Form Builder.

Workaround: Unlike in the earlier release of Form builder, CDE Browser search window is opened in a separate window/tab. Also, newly added Data Elements must be saved in CDE Browser before accessing them in the Form Builder. Below is the work flow to

access the newly added cart items in the Form Builder.

In Form Builder, click the CDE Cart icon located in the top right corner of the tool. On the CDE Cart page, click the "Add More Data Elements" button located in the center of the page. The CDE Browser will open in a new window or tab depending on the internet browser setting. On the CDE Browser Search screen, perform a search, select the desired Data Elements, and click the "Add to CDE Cart" button. This will add the selected Data Elements to the CDE Browser Cart. To use the Cart contents on a Form, click the CDE Cart icon located in the top right corner of the CDE Browser to open the cart page.

Select the added Data Elements and click the "Save" button. A login window will display. Enter your username and password used in Form Builder to log back into the tool. The selected Data Elements will be saved in your CDE Cart. Click the Form Builder Display CDE Cart window (should be open on your desktop) and click the "Refresh" button. The CDE Cart will update with the selected Data Elements.
